

ORDINANCE NO. 2296

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ERLANGER, IN KENTON COUNTY, KENTUCKY, REPEALING ORDINANCE # 2157 REGARDING THE REGULATION OF MOTOR VEHICLE TRAFFIC ON WATSON ROAD

WHEREAS, there have been significant changes in the development of the area adjacent to that part of Watson Road that is the subject of ordinance # 2157, to the extent that the regulations of the motor vehicle traffic established in that ordinance are no longer appropriate;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ERLANGER, IN KENTON COUNTY, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1.0 – Repeal

Ordinance 2157 of the City of Erlanger is hereby completely repealed.

Section 2.0 – Provisions Severable

The provisions of this ordinance are severable; and the invalidity of any provision of this ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other provision thereof; and such other provisions shall remain in full force and effect as long as they remain valid in the absence of those provisions determined to be invalid.

Section 3.0 – Conflicting Ordinances Repealed

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 4.0 – Effective Date

This ordinance shall be effective as soon as possible according to law.

Section 5.0 - Publication

This ordinance shall be published in summary pursuant to K.R.S. 83A.060 (9).
